MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

-  Essay of 250-500 words (double spaced and attached to application).

Applicants must submit an essay on one of the following subjects:

-  Money Management.
-  Importance of Good Credit.
-  Financial Literacy.
-  Interns must submit an essay outlining their experience while working at LFCU.

Field of Study:

Accounting, Business, Education,
Marketing, or Communications.¹

-  Need.
-  Leadership Activities.
-  Skills.
-  Service/Volunteer Activities.
-  Behavior.
-  Attendance.
-  Recommendation from Limestone FCU Team.
-  Interns: Recommendation from Executive Team.
-  Previous participation in Emerald Spirit Store, Student Branch, The Grind Coffee House, or Learn It. Plan It. Pitch It.

Scholarship Awards



High School Students

- \$500 per semester upon receipt of acceptance letter; second payment upon receipt of transcripts showing a 2.50 GPA or higher.¹

Interns

- \$1,000 payable at the end of internship.¹

¹Funds are remitted to college or university in students name.

¹High School Students: The 1st payment of \$500 will be paid for the first semester. A copy of the first semester's transcripts will need to be sent to LFCU to show a 2.5 GPA or higher to receive 2nd payment of \$500 for the second semester. Interns: \$1,000 payment will be paid at the end of the internship. Intern must complete a minimum of eight (8) weeks at LFCU to qualify.
